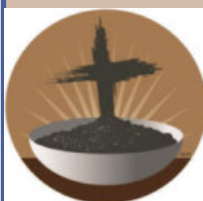

Baskets to collect last years blessed palms will be available at the church doors and in the Pastoral Services Center.

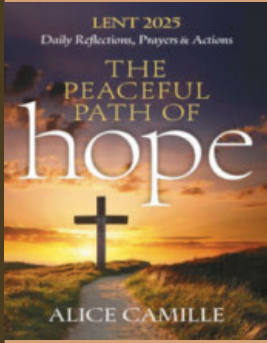

A Call to Faith and Devotion

Michael will share heartfelt words in his homilies, reminding us of the profound role stewardship plays in our



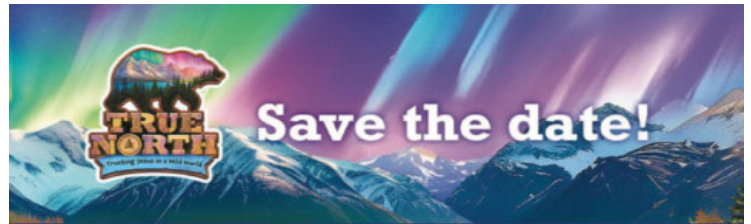


St. Aloysius Habitat for Humanity:

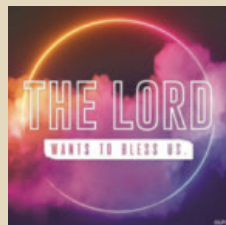
