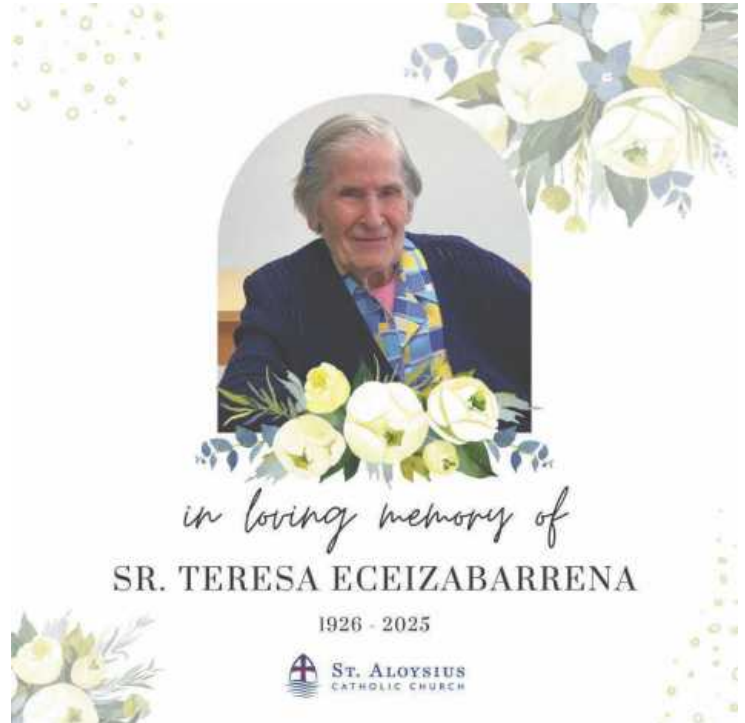

Dear St. Aloysius,

It is with deep sadness we share the news of the passing of Sister Teresa Eceizabarrena, one of our beloved Daughters of Jesus. Sr. Teresa served our parish from 1957-2002, first teaching 3rd Grade for a few years, then 2nd Grade at St. Aloysius Catholic School, and preparing children for their First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion. She was the last one remaining out of the group of sisters that served here from our parish's infancy to when they returned to Spain.

In the message to our parish, her Superior General shared this with us:

"In her memory and in her heart was very much alive the presence of St. Aloysius, its customs, its celebrations... During the time she has been in Spain there have been many communications with people from her parish and some of them have even come to Spain to visit her.

In St. Aloysius, she lived practically all her life. She carried in her heart the school, the children, the parish... She spent the last few years in our nursing home in San Sebastian (Spain), as she was in poor health, and today, January 1, she passed away.

We thank God for her long life, 98 years, and for her apostolic zeal that has led many people to know Jesus and to do good to others.

A prayer to the Lord for her."

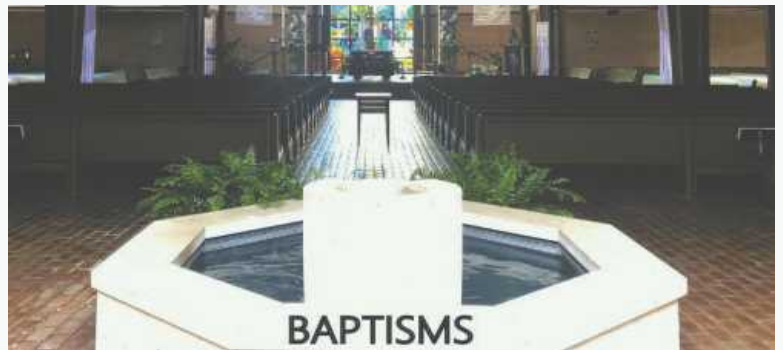

SPRING HOMESCHOOL PSR
First Grade

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion are traditionally observed when a child is in the second grade. In adherence to the policies of the Diocese of Baton Rouge, sacramental preparation requires **two** years of catechesis prior to receiving these sacraments.

If you have a child that you are hoping will receive these sacraments next year and has not been enrolled in a religious education program through a Catholic school or Parish School of Religion (PSR), St. Aloysius is offering a homeschool option in the spring 2025.
