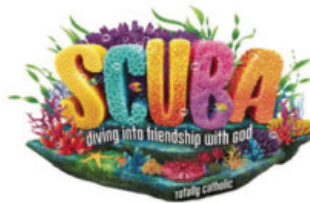

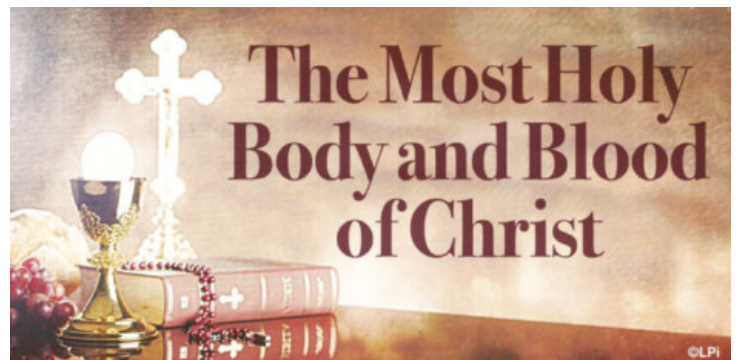

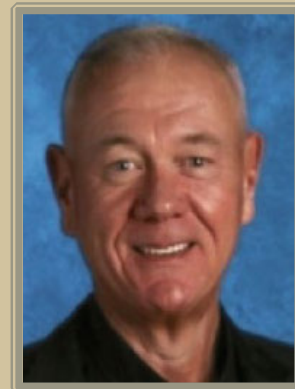

## Our Challenge



Dear friends:

Moses was ever-conscious of the covenant God had made with the people, which involved responsibilities to God and to other people. The covenant was sealed with the blood of a sacrificial offering. The blood represented the Israelites pledge to be true to God wherever the future might carry them. In the New Testament, the Epistle to the Hebrews is full of the language of the ancient sacrificial system. In this masterpiece we see why that system has been set aside. Christ has become our high priest and has shed his own blood on our behalf. Our proper worship is to give ourselves - - body and blood - - as living sacrifices to God. On the evening of Jesus' betrayal and arrest he felt only gratitude for his friends on earth and his Father in heaven. His last meal with his disciples became the sacrament of the Eucharist, our celebration of gratitude and joy because of God's sacrificial gift on our behalf. Twin truths about the human condition are found in Genesis and are assumed throughout the rest of the Bible. First, we are made for fellowship with God; second, we are not what we are meant to be. "In whatever direction we look - - in the realms of race, of color, of class, of culture, of community, of personal relationship of psychological adjustment - - one issue overshadows all others. It is that of Alienation, or Estrangement." (F. W. Dillistone) It has often been suggested that the basic sin underlying all others is the sin of ingratitude. This is the failure to recognize that life itself is a gracious gift from God. It is also the unwillingness to see how much we owe to other people for the things that sustain and enhance our lives. Passover is a Jewish festival commemorating the Exodus of the Jews and their liberation from Egyptian bondage. Jesus, being a Jew, had loved this tradition all his life. On his last night with his disciples he shared the Passover meal with them. None of them had any inkling of what this prefigured. Jesus himself, in a matter of hours, would be revealed as the Lamb of God, the perfect sacrifice, who died for the sins of the world.
