The Sacrament of Confirmation completes the grace of Baptism, more perfectly binds one to the Church, and enriches one with a special strength of the Holy Spirit.

Are you a baptized Catholic who has received the Sacraments of First Communion and First Reconciliation, is out of high school, but has not received the Sacrament of Confirmation? Contact Deacon Chauvin at cwilkinson@stalloysiusparish.com. He will send you an **application packet which should be completed and returned as soon as possible, before 02/14/2025.**

Adult Confirmation classes will be held from **6:30 to 8:00 PM on February 24, March 10, March 17, March 31, April 14, May 12, and May 19, 2025.**

Anyone interested should mark all these dates on their calendar. Presently, the class meetings are scheduled to be at St. Aloysius in the Edith Stein Room of Gonzaga Hall.

Your sponsor must be a confirmed and practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church.

Tentatively, the Rite of Confirmation with Bishop Duca is planned for the **10:30 AM Mass** at St. Joseph Cathedral on June 8, 2025.

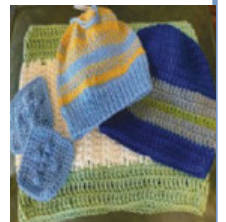

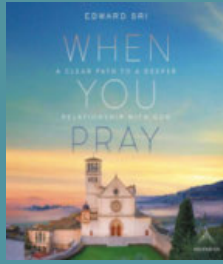

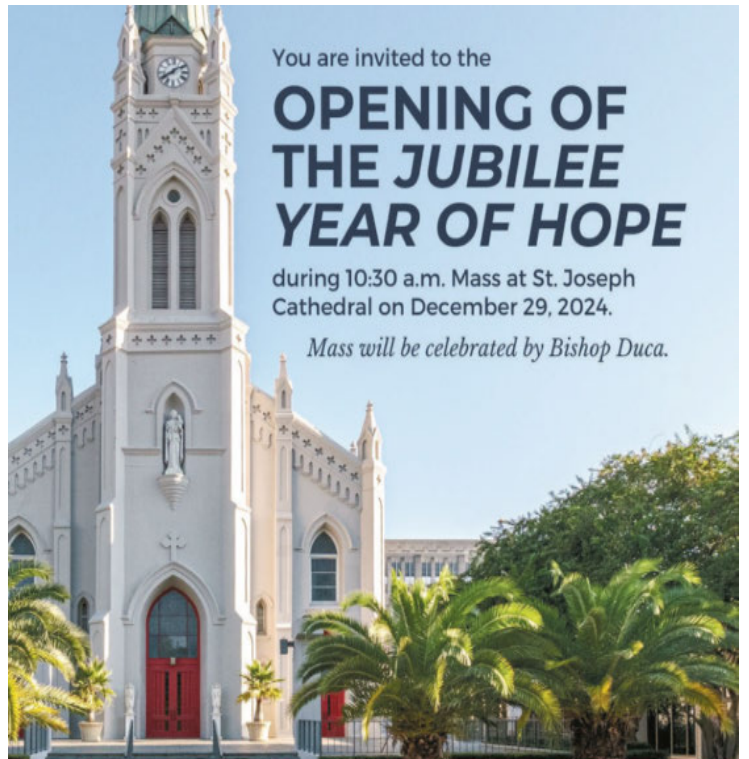

The Catholic Youth Leadership Award was established in 1959 by the Louisiana State Council. In the beginning the State Council recognized only boys and in 1971 the State Council began to recognize one boy and girl as their State CYLA Winners.

The CYLA Process

High School students complete an online CYLA application, and the application must be sponsored by a local Knights of Columbus Council.
 The local Council selects one boy and girl as their Council CYLA winners.
 The Local Council boy and girl winners are then sent to compete on a Diocesan Level.
 Each Diocesan boy and girl winner is provided a chance to participate in the State CYLA Finals.

SPRING HOMESCHOOL PSR

First Grade

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion are traditionally observed when a child is in the second grade. In adherence to the policies of the Diocese of Baton Rouge, sacramental preparation requires **two** years of catechesis prior to receiving these sacraments.

If you have a child that you are hoping will receive these sacraments next year and has not been enrolled in a religious education program through a Catholic school or Parish School of Religion (PSR), St. Aloysius is offering a homeschool option in the spring 2025.

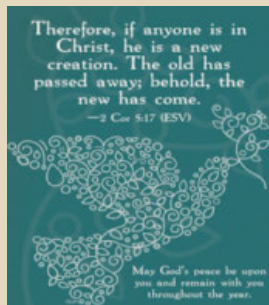
