





Our Challenge

Dear friends,

The New Testament should never be read merely as a record of events in the past. The Scriptures are a vehicle of God's Word to us now. Likewise, the Holy Spirit is the living presence of God in our lives today. Just as the Spirit enabled the first believers to build a strong community, despite their differences, it is present within us and among us now to give new life to the Body of Christ. We all have unique gifts to use in the service of Christ. One key to understanding how these gifts are to



be used is seeing whether they build up or tear down our Christian fellowship. The focus of our individual gifts must be on others and not on ourselves. Paul stresses that the gifts of the Spirit must build up the Body of Christ, not tear it apart. Breath was a sign of life for the ancient Hebrews, as it is for us today. In the act of breathing on his disciples, Jesus imparts something of his life to them. Breath is the animating principle of all creation. It is symbolic of God's gift of the Spirit to us. The Spirit energizes and motivates service for Christ on the part of his followers. In any human enterprise, if we are able to communicate effectively, we are well on the road to understanding, and perhaps agreement. The Holy Spirit facilitates communication within Christ's Church and between it and the world. It keeps us in touch with the teachings of Jesus. It inspires us to do God's will. It helps us understand our faith, not just with the mind, but in the heart and soul. And it opens avenues for our witness to the world for which Christ died. In Jesus Christ, God has become like us. We are invited to become like Christ. This is never done through the effort of the will alone. It is through submitting to the Spirit that we become like Christ. In many ways our world has become a very small place. We have made such advances in technology that we are only seconds away from contact with people on the other side of the world. This new efficiency and proximity has not produced peace, however. Conflicts remain, among nations, races, and religions. We must not trust in technology alone. The only hope for the world is the self-giving love revealed in God's Son, and made available through God's Spirit.




