## Come make a joyful noise, and join the St. Aloysius Parish Children's Choir!



## STEWARDSHIP through MINISTRY September 21 & 22

This year's theme for *Stewardship Through Ministry* is "*I thirst.*" When Jesus hung dying on the Cross, He simply uttered the words, "*I thirst.*" It was not merely for water that He thirsted. He also thirsted for our love and the salvation of souls. The human heart is restless until it finds God. We all hunger and thirst searching in mysterious places but are never quenched until we find God. We thirst for God and He thirsts for our Love. "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they will be filled."

St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta said, "Jesus is God, therefore His Love and His Thirst are infinite. He, the Creator of the universe, asked for the love of His creatures. He has thirst for our love... These words: "I THIRST" ... Do they echo in our soul?"

Mother Teresa spent most of her ministry serving and aiding the poor and suffering of Calcutta. There were times when she would encounter a person dying of thirst and would do anything she could to get them water. Taking this practical example, Mother Teresa challenges us to ask ourselves, *"Do I react the same to God's thirst of me as I would a man dying of thirst?"* Could we all spend more of our time helping others?

*Stewardship through Ministry* fulfills our need to return to God our time, talents, skills, and abilities. Through your ministry commitment and participation, we build God's Kingdom and help realize the vision and mission of our parish.

Whether you are new to St. Aloysius or have been a parishioner for a while, there is a place for you to serve and grow in your faith. ## **GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

#### 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

One of the most touching YouTube videos I've ever seen is one in which a deaf woman receives new technology to heal her hearing. She hears her husband's voice for the first time — and her own, too — and bursts into tears of overwhelming joy. It must have been like an im-movable wall between her and her loved ones came tumbling down.

We are all like this woman, to some degree. We believe in the presence of God's love, but we can't hear Him. We can't speak well about Him. The deaf man who can't speak properly in the Gospel today is an image of what God wants us to experience again and again. Jesus takes the man aside to a private place away from the crowd, touches his ears and tongue, and says, "**Ephphata**!" The man's ears are opened, and he speaks clearly. Contact with Christ has this effect on us.

This experience happens to us in our baptism, almost exactly. It happens to us in the liturgy. It happens in our private prayer. It happens when we hear the voice of God in our conscience. The more we engage these privileged channels of Jesus' healing, the more we are em-powered to hear and speak of the presence of God's perfect love.




